

ATLAS 103 ~ TREASURES OF CROATIA, B&H AND SERBIA

9 days from Zagreb to Plitvice Lakes, Trogir, Split, Dubrovnik, via Mostar to Sarajevo, Belgrade and Zagreb

Day 1, arrive Zagreb, Wednesday

Upon arrival at Zagreb Airport you will be transferred to your hotel where you will meet your tour guide and enjoy your first dinner in Croatia.

Day 2, Zagreb to Plitvice Lakes, Thursday

Enjoy a morning city tour of Zagreb, including the fortified Upper Town, the city's historical centre, St. Mark's Church with its multi-coloured roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University. After the city tour, we will continue to Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site, where we will be immersed in peace and serenity. Sixteen jewel-like lakes, each at a different level, are joined by a series of cascading waterfalls. Situated in a dense forest, the Plitvice Lakes are a natural phenomenon of rare and unique beauty.

Day 3, to Trogir and Split, Friday

The morning sun and the singing birds will wake you up to continue your adventure towards Trogir, a small historical jewel in the heart of Dalmatia. Here, history tells us about the Roman Empire at the Cathedral of St. Lawrence. We continue south to Split where the city tour takes you to the UNESCO World Heritage listed Diocletian's Palace with its Peristyle, the Temple of Jupiter and the Cathedral.



Day 4, Split to Dubrovnik, Saturday

After breakfast we depart for Dubrovnik and take a sightseeing tour of this spectacular, UNESCO protected, fortified city. The city walls are wide enough to walk on! Dubrovnik became the only eastern Adriatic city-state to rival Venice in the Middle Ages. We will visit the Franciscan monastery with Europe's third oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral.

Day 5, in Dubrovnik, Sunday

Spend the day exploring Dubrovnik at your leisure.

Day 6, Dubrovnik to Mostar and Sarajevo, Monday

Following breakfast, we depart for Mostar and a sightseeing tour of its



Old City, recently added to UNESCO's List of World Cultural Heritage sites. We tour its elegant Bridge, the Old Bazaar, the Mosque and a typical Turkish house. We then continue to Sarajevo for an afternoon city tour where we will see Baščaršija and Gazi Husref Bey Mosque.

Day 7, Sarajevo to Belgrade, Tuesday

Today we travel north-east to Belgrade, stopping for lunch along the way before continuing to Belgrade for dinner.

Day 8, Belgrade to Zagreb, Wednesday

Our morning tour of Belgrade includes a visit to the imposing Kalemegdan Fortress, dramatically set at the confluence of the Sava and Danube Rivers. You'll also see Republic Square and Knez Mihajlova Street, Saint Sava Temple, the largest Orthodox Church in the city, and Tito's Memorial. We return to Zagreb for dinner and overnight.

Day 9, Zagreb, Thursday

The tour ends after breakfast with your transfer to Zagreb Airport.
