

ATLAS 104 ~ HIGHLIGHTS OF CROATIA

8 days from Dubrovnik to Split, Trogir, Zadar, Zagreb, Plitvice Lakes and Trilj.



Day 1, arrive Dubrovnik, Sunday

Upon arrival at Dubrovnik Airport you will be transferred to your hotel where you will meet your tour guide and enjoy your first dinner in Croatia.

Day 2, Dubrovnik to Split, Monday

After breakfast, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Dubrovnik, the spectacular, UNESCO protected, fortified city. The city walls are wide enough to walk on! Dubrovnik became the only eastern Adriatic city-state to rival Venice in the Middle Ages. We will visit the Franciscan monastery with Europe's third oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral. In the afternoon we depart for Split, driving along the Adriatic Coast and the Neretva River Delta.

Day 3, Split to Trogir and Zadar, Tuesday

On the city tour of Split we will explore the UNESCO World Heritage listed Diocletian's Palace with its Peristyle, the Temple of Jupiter and the Cathedral. We then go north to Trogir, a pearl-like town in the heart of Dalmatia where the story of the Roman Empire is present in the walls of the Cathedral of St. Lawrence. We continue to Zadar for the night.

Day 4, Zadar to Zagreb, Wednesday

In the morning we tour the sights of Zadar, including the Roman Forum and St. Donatus Church, magnificent monuments of Romanesque architecture. We depart in the afternoon for Zagreb, Croatia's capital.

Day 5, Zagreb to Plitvice Lakes National Park, Thursday

Enjoy a morning city tour of Zagreb, including the fortified Upper Town,



the city's historical centre, St. Mark's Church with its multi-coloured roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University. After the city tour, we will continue to Plitvice Lakes National Park.

Day 6, Plitvice Lakes National Park, Friday

After breakfast, we tour the Plitvice Lakes National Park, one of Croatia's many UNESCO World Heritage sites. We will be immersed in peace and serenity as we visit the sixteen jewel-like lakes, each at a different level, joined by a series of cascading waterfalls. Situated in a dense forest, the Plitvice Lakes are a natural phenomenon of rare and unique beauty.

Day 7, Plitvice Lakes to Trilj and Dubrovnik, Saturday

In the morning, we depart for Dubrovnik, driving via Trilj and along the valley of the Cetina River.

Day 8, Dubrovnik, Sunday

The tour ends after breakfast with a transfer to Dubrovnik Airport.
