

## BUCHAREST INTERLUDE 2019



First mentioned in documents from 1459, Bucharest became the capital of Romania in 1862. Bucharest has an eclectic mix of architecture including historical, Art Deco and modern. In the period between the two World Wars, the city's elegant architecture and the sophistication of its elite earned Bucharest the nickname of "Little Paris". Today Bucharest has a very diverse cultural scene that incorporates various elements of traditional Romanian culture and international trends. Places that must be visited on a trip to Budapest include: Parliament Palace, the second largest administrative building in the world which took 700 architects to build; The Arch of Triumph, built to commemorate the bravery of Romanian soldiers in World War 1; Calea Victoriei, the city's oldest and most charming avenue.

In the afternoon continue to Bran to visit the castle made famous by Bram Stoker's novel Dracula, as the residence of the vampire count
